Dear SCUC ISD Parents and Students (*Marching Band 9th graders and new participants*):

Due to the challenges surrounding Covid-19, The University Interscholastic League (UIL) and SCUC ISD have worked to adjust our processes for UIL Pre-Participation Physical Evaluations (PPE). In SCUC, we have temporarily suspended our policy that requires every student involved in athletics/marching band to have a PPE every year. UIL has recently modified their policy that required a PPE during the "1st year of JH athletics, 1st year of HS athletics, and 3rd year of HS athletics". As of 5-1-2020, UIL's new policy states:

"Any participant in athletics or marching band, in any grade level, who has NOT previously completed a Pre-Participation Physical Evaluation (PPE), and been cleared for participation, will be required to complete the Medical History Form, as well as a PPE prior to participation in any UIL practices, games, performances, or matches. "

In SCUC, for the 2020-2021 school year, ALL new student participants to UIL athletics and/or marching band will need a PPE prior to practices and participation in UIL contests. For Marching Band, our incoming 9th grade students will be our largest group that will need PPE's. *Students that received a PPE for JH athletics will not need one for 9th grade marching band.*

ALL students participating in UIL marching band and/or UIL athletic activities will need to complete the online forms at <https://www.rankonesport.com/content/>.
