District 27 6A lifts ban on band travel:

As we have all experienced over and over during COVID, things are changing again. District 27 has voted to allow bands (and other groups) to travel to away games, but has left it up to individual schools/districts to keep the ban if they prefer.

What does this mean? It means we will be taking a *small* pep-band to Judson next Thursday, Oct. 15th. Since we built our calendar around the understanding that we would *not* be traveling, we will be taking volunteers who wish to go to the game, starting with seniors, and working down to our younger members. Students will sign up through a Google Form. *Color Guard and Front Ensemble will not be performing, but will still have a set number of spots available to them to attend the game.*

Students will be required to wear a mask on the buses for the short trip to Rutledge Stadium, and each student will have their own seat. This trip will not be required for any student.

It is currently unclear whether New Braunfels (our only other away game) will allow visiting bands. More info will be forthcoming.
